Dear Mr. Moore:

Reference is made to the Department of the Army permit SAJ-2001-3870 issued to the South Amelia Island Shore Protection. Florida Park Service – Amelia Island State Park, and the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners on March 17, 2011. The permit authorized the placement of 2 million cubic yards of sand along 17,900 feet of shoreline on South Amelia Island. The project is located along the beach of South Amelia Island, from R-59.5 southward to R-78, in Sections 1, 6, 18, 22, 29, and 38, Townships 1 north and 2 north, Ranges 28 east and 29 east, Amelia Island, Nassau, Florida.

A representative of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) reviewed the submitted as-built drawings on March 7, 2012; these were submitted under transmittal dated September 30, 2011, by Olsen Associates, Inc. The information was received on October 4, 2011. Review of the as-builts confirmed the work authorized by the permit has been completed and is in compliance. Corps personnel reviewed the file for this project and noted all conditions of the permit have been met and no further action will be required.

In accordance with the General Conditions the Permittee is required to maintain the project in good condition and if the property is sold, the permit should be transferred to the new property owner. Although there is a time limit for completing the authorized work, the permit with its conditions does not expire.
