For the past 25 years, property owners within the boundaries of the South Amelia Island Shore Stabilization Association (SAISSA) have committed to preserving and protecting our beach and dunes by helping fund beach restoration and renourishment. The need to once again renourish our beach is fast approaching. While many long-time property owners may recall some of the history of SAISSA and previous beach restoration and renourishment efforts, many new owners may know little about this history and these efforts.
